

SNOW ADVISORY

IN PREPARATION OF SNOW REMOVAL THE FOLLOWING SHOULD BE ADHERED TO:

- WHENEVER POSSIBLE PARK ALL VEHICLES OFF THE ROAD.
- BASKETBALL POLES/HOOPS SHOULD BE REMOVED FROM THE CURB LINE OR TURNED AROUND.

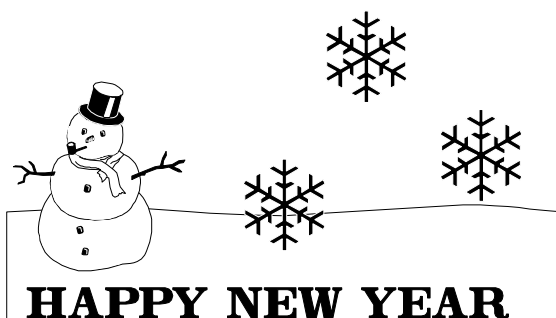

ENGINEER'S CORNER—Edward Broberg, P.E.—Borough Engineer

Route 36 Bridge Replacement— The State of New Jersey Department of Transportation will be replacing the Route 36 bridge over Flat Creek. The construction contract was awarded to Cruz Contracting, LLC. NJDOT anticipates construction to begin late December 2007 and be completed by January 2010.

Sidewalk Rehabilitation along County Roads—The Borough of Union Beach and County of Monmouth recently completed the seventh phase of the rehabilitation program of curbs and sidewalks along county roads within the Borough. This year's phase included new curb and sidewalks along the northerly side of Stone Road from Florence Avenue to Poole Avenue and from Donnelly Street to Anderson Street.

Rehabilitation of Scholer Park—Phase II—The Mayor and Council have submitted an application to the Monmouth County Open Space Grant Program for the rehabilitation of Scholer Park—Phase II. The anticipated improvements include the reconstruction of the parking lots, the construction of a rest room / concession building and additional landscaping and park amenities. If the Borough is successful in obtaining the funding, we anticipate construction to begin in the Fall of 2008.

Reconstruction of Pine Street— The Borough recently completed the reconstruction of Pine Street from Park Avenue north to Eighth Street. The project was funded in part through a grant from the Monmouth County Community Development Program in the amount of \$200,259.00. The project consisted of the new concrete curbs, sidewalks, drainage and the total reconstruction of the existing roadway.
